: WHY YAKIMA? :

DIURNAL SHIFT:

THIS IS PART OF WHAT MAKES WA STATE SUCH A SPECIAL GROWING REGION.

Sedimentary soils were deposited in the Yakima Valley by the Missoula floods. The high alkalinity and calcium carbonate content of the soil, along with its granular consistency, allows for vines to form a well established root system.

In soils with this composition, root systems are able to reach deep to obtain the necessary nutrients and moisture. Phylloxera struggles in Washington State so many of our vines are ungrafted.

The high latitude (N 46*) and topography contribute temperature swings experienced during the growing season, with daytime temperatures averaging 32 $^{\circ}$ and night time temperatures dropping below 10 $^{\circ}$.

The hot days and cool nights help retain acidity in the grapes, extraction, and lends itself to balanced and structured wines.

: RED WILLOW VINEYARD :

James Beard Nominee Red Willow Vineyard, is the furthest western vineyard within the Yakima Valley AVA. Founded in 1971, Red Willow is one of the oldest vineyards in Washington State and is still owned and operated by the Sauer family. Their vines are grown on steep hillsides, with unique formations of soils unlike any other.

: ARTZ VINEYARD :


Developed by the late Fred Artz this vineyard is planted on a slight north facing slope on Red Mountain in the Yakima Valley AVA. Red Mountain is a perfect growing region for Cabernet Sauvignon. The wind here moves frequently from the southwest and the gusts of airflow keep grape clusters small and the skins thick which concentrates the flavors of the fruit and the richness of the tannins.

: CIEL DU CHEVAL :

First planted in 1975 on Red Mountain in the Yakima Valley AVA. When the great Spokane Flood formed the Red Mountain region, the Scooteney Channel backed up leaving deposits of gravel and huge stones. The Ciel du Cheval soil is composed of loam on gravel beds which extend 12 feet or more. Our fruit comes from Clone 337. Fruit from this vineyard exceptional color, strength and richness, while demonstrating remarkable balance of fruit, acidity, and tannin.

: Two Blondes Vineyard :

Andrew Will Winery's estate vineyard. This vineyard is the coolest site that we work with and that lends itself to a very aromatic wine full of floral components and more delicate tannins than some of our hottest sites.





JB NEUFELD YAKIMA VALLEY OLD GOAT RED WILLOW VINEYARD 2020

Generously fruity and handsomely spicy, this full-bodies wine wraps melted tannins around indulgent dried cherry, sweet plum, cinnamon and cedar flavors. It's bid, broad and easy to sip. 56% cabernet sauvignon, 22% merlot, 11% malbec and 11% petit verdot. Drink now or hold.











JB NEUFELD CABERNET SAUVIGNON YAKIMA VALLEY TWO BLONDES VINEYARD 2021

Exotic and deep, the wine is steeped in blackberry, blueberry, star anise and balsam notes that have a haunting complexity. Almost-silky tannins lend a little grip to the texture without interrupting the wine's velvety flow. Drink or hold.



JB NEUFELD CABERNET SAUVIGNON RED MOUNTAIN CIEL DU CHEVAL VINEYARD 2021

Firm tannins and well-ripened red and black fruit give this wine a hearty, robust expression. The nicely gripping texture carries red cherries, black cherries and sun-baked earth nuances. Best from 2028.







JB NEUFELD CABERNET SAUVIGNON YAKIMA VALLEY 2021

Juicy, concentrated and straightforward, this sturdy wine is packed with black cherries and blackberries on a firm, tannic structure. Blended with 14% merlot that didn't soften it too much.



JB NEUFELD SAUVIGNON BLANC 2022

A fruity white with aromas of lime zest, lemon curd, guavas and green apples. Medium-bodied, sharp and refreshing with a zesty finish. Drink now. Screw cap.
